

Presentation Guidelines

<For Oral Presentation>

- Presentation Time (Questions and Answers)
 - Plenary Lectures: 35 min (5 min); 40 min total
 - Invited Lectures: 25 min (5 min); 30 min total
 - Nagoya University Students: 15 min (5 min); 20 min total
 - Tohoku University Students: 12 min (3 min); 15 min total
 - AMC Students: 10 min (5 min); 15 min total

- Time keeper will ring a bell 3 times during each presentation.

- Presenting Universities and Laboratories
 - Student should introduce their universities (and/or their laboratories) at the beginning or at the end of their presentation.
 - Invited: 3 – 5 slides (introduction of the university and the laboratory)
 - Tohoku Univ. (except for AMC) : 1 – 2 slides (introduction of the laboratory)
- Computers
 - Win & Mac computers will be available for use during the talks. Presenters can also use their own computers. Presenters should have your presentation file backed up on a USB memory stick and ready at hand, in case anything goes wrong during your presentation. Presenters should prescreen their own slides during the break before their own presentations.

<For Poster Presentation>

- Poster presentation will be held on the first day of the Meeting (Aug. 27th).
- Poster should be put in place from the afternoon on Aug. 26th to lunch on Aug. 27th, and to be removed after lunch on Aug. 28th.
- Presentation Time
 - Odd number 13:15-14:15
 - Even Number 14:15-15:15
- The size of the poster boards: 90 × 130 cm². (A0 = 84.1 × 118.9 cm²)
